## **Cookies Policy**

## What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on a user's computer or mobile device temporarily or permanently. Cookies are used to recognize users and track of their preferences.

<u>First-Party Cookies:</u> First-party cookies are created, set and accessed by the website. They are usually used to store website preferences and to maintain the browser session.

<u>Third-Party Cookies:</u> Third-party cookies are provided by external services/providers. They are usually used to provide targeted advertisement.

<u>Temporary Cookies</u>: Temporary cookies are deleted from your device when the session ends or the browser is closed.

<u>Persistent Cookies:</u> Persistent cookies are stored in the user's device forever or for a specific length of time. Ending the session or closing the browser does not delete persistent cookies.

## What cookies do we use?

_ga	Used to distinguish users.
_gid	Used to distinguish users.
_gat	Used to throttle request rate.

## How can you manage cookies?
